FIRST, DO NO HARM

A Diagnosis of the American Health System

Narration Script
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TITLE SEQUENCE: Camera tracks past endless bottles of soda pop, candy bars, fruit juices, potato chips as line items in a \$71,000 hospital bill superimpose. In the background we hear the receptionist at a doctors office telling a heart attack patient that he can't get an appointment for 3 months.

THE HIPPOCRATIC OATH:

NARRATOR

The American Health System is a multi-trillion dollar racket. It does not care about anyone's health.

Doctors are more interested in leaving the office early for the Labor Day weekend than seeing a patient who has had a heart attack. Americans receive better care for their dogs and cats.

In short: the American Health System is a carnival of freak shows from the sugar-saturated food industry to profit-obsessed drug companies. From over-priced hospitals to parasitic insurance companies that feast on the carcases of sick and harmed Americans.

In fact the Hippocratic Oath Medical Doctors swear to uphold -- "First, do no HARM" -- is a JOKE. The real Oath is more like:

First, make money;

Second, minimize hours;

Third, never answer the phone;

Forth, make patients wait forever;

Fifth, have a nasty receptionist;

Sixth, never prevent anything;

THE ENGINE OF SICKNESS:

The so-called American "Food" Industry -- more accurately the Engine of Sickness -- initiates the chain of health care insanity.

What WE THE PEOPLE call "food" is more like slow-acting poison. At least rat poison is quick. The motto: "First, get their money, then poison them slowly so they don't notice". This is the Food Industry's Hippocratic Oath.

Yes, the American Food Industry has been partners in crime with the American Health Industry for over 100 years. Together they have evolved the perfect System to poison WE THE PEOPLE, extract a lifetime of cash flow and then make them too sick and weak to retaliate.

The "food" we eat is a freak show of fake delights. Sugar, salt and fat make it taste good. High-fructose corn syrup makes it cheap to manufacture. "Bliss point" chemicals make it addictive. Preservatives keep it rotting forever. Carbs make us fat.

Eventually, after decades of sugar, salt, fat, corn syrup, chemicals, preservatives and carbs -- we get SICK.

But no worry, the American Pharmaceutical Industry comes to the rescue.

BIG PHARMA:

After eating 40 years of sugar-coated rat poisoning, Americans are now ready for Big Pharma's patented pills.

And the pills are great. Just like the 1960s, a generation of BabyBoomers is partying again -- but not with rogue drugs cooked in basement labs. Big Pharma's drugs are made in multi-billion labs with advanced bio-tech. Sex, drugs and rock and roll was never so sophisticated.

Unfortunately the very pills that are supposed to make us happy, high and healthy, harm us with a spectrum of "side affects."

Yes, Big Pharma has its own Hippocratic Oath. "First, promise relief and pleasure, then make them permanently sick." In this way Big Pharma creates an endless stream of repeat customers, not only for themselves, but for their cronies in the American Health System.

Endless drugs soon become "necessary" to cure the "side effects" of endless drugs.

Soon, doctor's offices are so flooded with WE THE SICK, it takes 2 or 3 months to get an appointment, even for a routine check up.

The lack of check ups then places millions on the road to chronic illness. Addictions to sugar-saturated foods and chemical-saturated drugs continue to grow.

Eventually the American Health System explodes. Too many undernourished, over-medicated people seeking too few physicians.

OUTRAGEOUS PRICES:

As the quality and quantity of services in the American Health System continue to decline, prices continue to explode.

500 dollars for a pill. 10 thousand dollars for a doctor visit. 35 thousand dollars for a night in the hospital.

What are WE THE SICK to do when we can't pay?! We go bankrupt. We lose our houses. We get sicker or die.

Again, whether by accident or design, the American Health System has evolved into an enterprise of extortion -- grand larceny fueled by the ever-present threat of harm.

Like the Military-Industrial Complex, the American Health System extorts money from WE THE PEOPLE because an individual (or Society) will spend almost any amount when threatened with disease (or War).

Unfortunately there are entities and mentalities that exploit this propensity. Psychopaths like this are destroying American lives.

Yes, the System has become a monster, populated by insensitive, uncaring people who exploit WE THE SICK, especially the elder and poor. Even though the Hippocratic Oath says "do no harm," the current System does great harm. And this doesn't even include iatrogenic harm -- harm done by medical mistakes.

Whether food-poisoning, side-effects, diseases -- AlQaeda, ISIS or the Taliban, it seems without an enemy there are no profits. This is a sad commentary on the human condition.

The American Medical System is supposed to protect WE THE PEOPLE from food-poisoning, side effects, diseases and the Military-Industrial Complex is supposed to protect us from Al-Qaeda, ISIS and the Taliban. But does either accomplish its mission? Consider 9/11 and COVID.

Both health and military organizations use the police powers of the state to impose endless taxes, debt, fees, premiums and deductibles.

THE INSURANCE THEORY OF HEALTH CARE:

Eventually, as health care prices escalate into the stratosphere, the only way WE THE SICK can pay is to take out insurance policies. Multi-billion dollar insurance companies thus emerge.

The public is now deep in the hands of mathematical sharks who promise to take "care" of us through the magic of actuary.

As these freaky wizards "care" for our expenses, prices continue to escalate.

Expenses would be affordable if health care were subject to free market competition.

Just as pharmaceuticals cause side effects, insurance causes high prices. The very prices we insure against are caused BY insurance.

This is called moral hazard. To the degree doctors and hospitals know insurance will pay, they charge more. Prices rise. To the degree people know insurance will pay their medical bills, they eat more and exercise less. Prices rise.

When rising prices are covered by insurance, WE THE SICK have an incentive to increase our exposure to health risks because we do not bear the costs of those risks.

The "insurance theory of health care" -- whether private or government -- causes risks to accumulate.

The "pay-as-you-go theory of health care" addresses risks in real time.

The "insurance theory of health care" -- whether private or government -- causes prices to rise.

The "pay-as-you-go theory of health care" addresses prices in real time.

Apologists of Big Insurance - whether private or government -- claim that large pools of the insured have a better bargaining position against hospitals, doctors and drug companies. Such "economies of scale" may be true in many industries, but in the long-term incentivising risk over a vast population will always cause MORE risk, hence, prices rise. Also, since we all die, it's insane to insure the inevitable. If Johnny totaled his car every week, how smart would it be to insure Johnny.

Hospitals, doctors and drug companies, being only human, will exploit deep-pocket insurance companies at every opportunity. If true, why expose WE THE SICK to the risk of the "insurance theory of health care" when the "pay-as-you-go theory" will stimulate competition that will permanently lower prices and improve quality.

The short answer is this: there are entities and mentalities that do NOT want lower health care prices.

Such laugh all the way to the bank as they take 3-day weekends and early vacations. Look at the parking lots of medical buildings -- vacant by 4PM Thursdays through Mondays. Practically empty Fridays and the month of August. True to their Oath -- "First, make money; Second, minimize hours" -- greedy doctors and hospitals exploit greedy insurance companies and then these insurance companies exploit WE THE SICK.

As middlemen, insurance companies are mathematical wizards at exploiting hospitals, doctors, drug companies AND WE THE sick. They even have an Oath of their own: "First, insure the impossible, then refuse to pay anyone!"

Yes, when insurance companies are hit with outrageous bills from hospitals, doctors and Big Pharma, they often refuse to pay even though they demand WE THE SICK pay with stratospheric deductibles.

So WE pay or WE go into bankruptcy, lose our house or die. Doctors and hospitals, on the other hand, write off unpaid bills and still go into profits.

The American Health System is a swamp of outrageous inequities. Hospital bills. Absentee doctors. Poisonous food. Side effects. competition-starved innovation. Yes, WE THE SICK are at the mercy of Big Insurance and a cadre of Medical Terrorists.

OPACITY & SPECIAL PRIVILEGES:

Eventually the price-gouging becomes so insidious, hospitals, doctors and drug companies avoid publishing their prices.

No price transparency means they can charge whatever their sick, demented imaginations dictate -- extortion made possible by the threat of harm and the "insurance theory of health care."

Eventually the extortion-based, opaque price structure leads to a financial anarchy that ravages the Land like a California wildfire.

As the "insurance theory of health care" drives prices ever higher, the American Medical System lobbies Congress for "special privileges."

The passage of special privilege legislation, like "Citizens United," then gives the American Medical System the ability to raise money via both demonic political parties. Yes, the welfare-warfare state -- hiding behind the Democrat and Republican Parties -- makes money first by harming citizens with perpetual war and then "healing" them with perpetual, over-priced health "care."

Given this Nefarious System of institutionalized extortion, what could be more useful than multi-billion dollar pools of campaign funds that are totally opaque?! The motto being, "First, conceal the donors, then pass legislation that increases profits."

Thus high on the list of special privilege legislation are laws that inhibit competition. A prime example is legislation that forbids insurance companies from competing across state lines. Anti-competitive laws like this enable the biggest players to destroy smaller players. Large public corporations lobbied to pass NAFTA and GATT and this destroyed the American manufacturing base. The Health Care Monster does no less.

Innovative medical start-ups and smaller health care organizations that offer cost-effective, natural remedies -- like vitamins, supplements, pastoral counseling and meditation -- are suppressed, never incentivised.

And keeping the American Medical Monster in place is a network of institutionalized, brain-washing machines known as medical schools.

THE CHEMICAL THEORY OF HEALTH:

Some history you never got in the government-funded public school system:

Since 1910, medical schools have been indoctrinating medical students -- future MDs -- with the "chemical theory of health."

This theory is imposed on "med students" because most of the major medical schools were funded by grants from Rockefeller Foundations. The Rockefeller Group -- formerly a partner with Nazi Germany's largest chemical cartel, I.G. Farben -- owns the largest petroleum companies in the world.

Since most of Big Pharma's drugs are derived from Rockefeller-controlled petroleum, it's easy to see why MDs are expected to issue "prescriptions" for petroleum-based "meds" every time a patient leaves their office.

As a result, what could be called the "nutrition theory of health" has been suppressed, or removed entirely, from the curricula of Rockefeller-funded medical schools.

Also, since naturally-occurring remedies can't be patented, only chemically-synthesized drugs are funded by the American Health System.

Recouptment of investment on patented chemical-based remedies thus becomes more important than providing health care or discovering new treatments. In fact, Big Pharma would rather buy back their stock than invest profits in R&D.

But the American Medical Monster doesn't stop there: 15-year patents granted by the welfare-warfare state enable Big Pharma to monopolize life-saving chemical remedies, all in the name of profit.

Again, the cost of health "care" continues to rise because deep-pocket insurance companies drive up the prices while the state enables patent monopolies to thrive.

THE BRAIN-WASHING MEDIA:

After "Med School", the second level of brainwashing is targeted at the general public.

At this level the "chemical theory of health" is not only perpetuated, it's drilled in by the profit-obsessed Mainstream Media in their partnership with Big Pharma.

Yes a small group of senior executives dominates the TV Networks and is in partnership with Big Pharma. This CONTROL GROUP broadcasts endless TV commercials promoting, recommending and endorsing Big Pharma's drugs.

"Ask your doctor." How often have you heard that phrase on network TV?

This is a covert way the Networks and Big Pharma are really saying: "Tell your doctor". Tell your doctor to buy and use Big Pharma's product no matter how many side effects or deaths it causes.

It's high time the Mainstream Media is accountable for its role in "practicing medicine without a license" by subversively using physicians to promote what medications WE THE BRAINWASHED use.

To the degree the American Health System condones this practice, it's an accomplice to a multi-billion dollar criminal partnership. Just like cigarettes and narcotics, pharmaceutical drugs should not be promoted on network TV. Neither should other poisons, like alcohol and sugar.

MEDICAL TERRORISM:

The criminal partnership between Big Pharma, Academia and the Mainstream Media goes further.

Based on exorbitant-prices, extortion, subversive advertising, anti-competitive business practices and long-term propaganda from Rockefeller indoctrinated medical schools -- the American Health System is more than a racket, it's effectively a Terrorist Organization.

An extreme characterization? Consider this: the American Health System could be described as an organization that will kill you (let you die) if you don't pay (play by its rules).

More precisely, it's a multi-trillion dollar Symbiote, financed by insurance cabals under the protection of the welfare-warfare state, indoctrination by Academia and promotion by the Mainstream Media.

In short -- a massive Death and Disease Machine that feeds off taxpayers as it perpetuates itself and HARMS the lives, liberties and happiness of millions of Americans each and every day.

Given the nature of the American Medical Monster it would be no surprise if factions of it partnered with Communist China to create and release COVIOD-19 so vaccinations could be sold to an infected world.

It's time WE THE PEOPLE take a "holistic" view of the American Health System and diagnose the problem. It's time WE THE SICK force Medical Terrorists to start applying the Hippocratic Oath to higher standards than just 'doing no harm.'

THE MD MILITIA:

But let's face the facts. WE THE PEOPLE are not going to have much effect on the Medical Terrorists who are destroying America in the name of "health care." WE THE SICK are not going to reform a complex, biology-based industrial complex such as the American Health System.

The only ones who can cause such reform -- force change -- are the clinicians -- especially MDs -- who step up to leadership positions.

If this idea has merit, we need to encourage MDs across America to unite into a fighting political force, a force that can stand up to the ignorant and parasitic profit-driven administrative mentalities that have corrupted the field of Medicine and Mental Health.

Most doctors went into medicine to help people -- but they were corrupted by Rockefeller-funded universities and profit-psycho pharmaceutical corporations.

Given this, WE THE PEOPLE need an army of doctors who are willing to tell corporate lobbyists, ambulance-chasing lawyers, insurance sharks, TV charlatans, pharmaceutical marketing execs, revolving door Congressmen and health care psychopaths -- what could collectively be called the Medical Terrorist Establishment -- to get lost.

We need an "MD Militia" that is ready, able and willing to fight the Medical Terrorists that have infiltrated our health care system.

But no one is going to listen to anyone who doesn't even understand how the human body functions. What hospital administrator, insurance agent or congressman knows anything about physiology? None. So why are THESE idiots in charge?! Why should members of the Medical Terrorist Establishment make policy or give directives about a health care system?

Only MDs like Rand Paul are qualified. Dr. Paul is a Medical Doctor. He is also a U.S. Senator. He therefor has both technical AND administrative experience which he can viably apply to the reform of the American Health System. Bureaucrats and others are not qualified.

WE THE PEOPLE are confused and stupefied by the immensity of the problem. So are many MDs because men of science usually have little experience, or interest, in management, let alone politics.

Many MDs have been stupefied by endless red tape, onerous administrative procedures, arcane regulations and insane laws. In short, they have been stupefied by "the paperwork of socialized medicine since the 1960s" -- as the late Eugene A. Jaeger MD, put it.

But MDs have at least one thing that qualifies them for duty -- knowledge of the Scientific Method. So powerful is science, you can die if you don't listen to your doctor. On the other hand, if you listen to medical administrators, you probably WILL die.

Congressmen, lawyers, judges, executives and parasitic profiteers do NOT have the power of life and death -- they only have the power of DEATH. The government, any government, specializes in the application of force. In other words, DEATH. Only a doctor has the power to specialize in LIFE.

An MD Militia needs to understand and USE this power. MDs need to take charge, assume leadership roles. If an apparatchik gets in the way, or is inhibiting the work of a physician, that physician needs to be able to blow the little worm away.

Principles set forth in the Hippocratic Oath, free market economics and the U.S. Constitution should be supervised and enforced by MDs. If this happens, the American Health System will be in a position to "first, do no harm" -- and THEN start doing some good.

WHO PAYS:

Who should pay for health care is perhaps the most hotly-debated question in modern politics. Here are the basic options:

- 1) The individual who demands health care services;
- 2) Private insurance companies;
- 3) The state through taxation of citizens.
- 4) A combination of 1 - 3.

The American Health Care System currently uses option 4, a combination of options 1 - 3.

This System is a chaotic mess of government and private insurance intermingled with world War II corporate health care plans, individual deductions and co-pays. In short, it's insane. Terrorist Organizations are usually better organized.

Other than the rank insanity of the current System, there is a major difference between options 2 through 4 and option 1.

In option 1 the individual pays and has no help from either the state or insurance companies. Option 1 therefore imposes the maximum burden and responsibility upon the individual. No deep-pockets to come to the rescue.

But, as we have seen in this documentary, the primary reasons health care is so expensive is because the food supply is poison; Big Pharma's drugs have endless side-effects; and medical students are not sufficiently educated about preventative measures -- such as nutrition, vitamins, exercise, meditation.

As long as HEALTH is impeded, health CARE will be necessary. To the degree there is greater demand for CARE than supply of CARE, CARE will be expensive, hence HEALTH CARE INSURANCE -- government or private -- will be necessary because WE THE SICK will be infinite.

Infinite demand for health care services leads to infinite prices.

In this scenario the "insurance theory of health care" will prevail. The "pay as you go theory of health care" will only prevail if the cost of heath care is low enough the individual can afford it.

These things said, many will shutter in horror at the idea that individuals would have to PAY for their health care as if health care were a RIGHT. Is it?

RIGHTS:

There are three distinct questions and these are often commingled.

- 1) Does one have a RIGHT to have HEALTH?
- 2) Does one have a right to have HEALTH CARE?
- 3) Does one have a right to have HEALTH CARE INSURANCE?

Questions 1, 2 and 3 are not the same question. By commingling these three questions one can manipulate issues surrounding the American Health System.

Many view HEALTH as an inalienable RIGHT. They view it on the same level as other rights acknowledged in the U.S. Constitution -- i.e.

Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.

Many view HEALTH CARE as an inalienable RIGHT. One could reason that, if one of the enumerated inalienable rights is Life, health CARE could be seen as a subset -- you can't be alive unless you take CARE of your HEALTH.

So let's agree, HEALTH and HEALTH CARE are inalienable rights, and they are sanctioned by language in the U.S. Constitution.

But the third question: Does one have a right to have HEALTH CARE INSURANCE is sticky.

Insurance is needed when the costs of care are so high the individual cannot pay them. If the individual can't pay them, many will argue government insurance should pay. So does one have a right to have the government pay?

Many would argue that, if the province of government is protection, and security is a result of protection -- one DOES have a right to have HEALTH CARE INSURANCE provided by the government.

If one deems the state should pay for insurance, this means the taxpayers are paying for the insurance. WE THE PEOPLE are thus paying for each other's health care. I pay for you and you pay for me.

If nature makes Johnny healthy but has given Billy bad DNA, Johnny will have to pay for Billy's care but Billy will not have to pay anything for Johnny's care.

If on the other hand if both Johnny and Billy have great DNA but Johnny smokes cigarettes, eat tons of sugar, pops all manner of Big Pharma's pills and piles up a car every week -- Johnny is going to get sick more often. Billy will thus have to pay for Johnny's health care. Is that fair, or does Billy have the RIGHT to demand Johnny live a healthier life style?

In other words, if I demand the right to have you pay for my health care INSURANCE through the government, do you have the right to use the police powers of the state to demand I live a healthy life style?

If one goes down the road to making the taxpayers pay for each other's health care INSURANCE that road could be quite bumpy, if not impossible to sort out philosophically or practically.

INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBILITY:

If the individual -- or the individual purchasing private insurance -- draws on free market practices to exercise his right to have HEALTH and health CARE, this scenario seems to be far less invasive. Perhaps it doesn't seem as friendly or cooperative as insurance from Uncle Sam -- what's called "single payer" -- but if the System is re-calibrated to the specifications suggested in this film, the "ideal scene," later discussed, could come about.

IF free market competition inspires innovation as it does for every industry in the world; if individual bargaining power creates transparency and lowers prices; if individuals take better care of themselves because they have to pay -- THEN individuals CAN pay.

Private insurance and government insurance may become obsolete, but the greater good over the long-term would become a reality.

Of course, profit-seeking insurance companies and the ever-expanding welfare-warfare state do NOT want to entertain a scenario whereby medical health care prices are coming down to the point whereby individuals CAN pay, CAN afford them.

As stated at the beginning of this documentary: the American Health System -- which includes the private and government insurance systems -- "does not care about anyone's health." How would such a System make money unless it can manufacture and exploit WE THE SICK.

How would the Medical Terrorist Establishment continue if people took better care of themselves; MDs were better educated; the food supply was not poison; and free market competition drove the cost of medical technology down? If these things happened, the entire System would go the way of the American Computer Industry - cheap, endlessly improving and ubiquitous.

So all considerations as to whether health care is a right or a privilege have nothing to do with who pays, or who CAN pay.

If WE THE PEOPLE have a Constitutional right, an inalienable right, to health care, then any entity that inhibits that right is in effect abetting genocide. After all, a lot of people die if they can't get health care because some power-hungry entity is lobbying to rig the System.

Thus, to the degree medical technology is so expensive only big insurance companies or the state can pay for it, the American Health System is headed in the wrong direction.

BARRIERS TO REFORM:

The straw man argument presented by apologists of the current American Health System can be framed by the following question: Does one have a right to have HEALTH, health CARE or health care INSURANCE?

Again, these questions are vastly different.

By mixing the terms HEALTH and HEALTH CARE into the mix, apologists of the Medical Terrorist Establishment attempt to force the public discussion into a box -- either GOVERNMENT insurance or PRIVATE insurance. Of course everyone wants and deserves "HEALTH" and "HEALTH CARE" -- but everyone does not want HEALTH CARE INSURANCE. This bait and switch argument always leads to the "insurance theory of health care" and away from the "pay as you go theory of health care."

Either health care is expensive and paid for by insurance or health care is cheap and paid for by the individual. The Medical Terrorist Establishment wants to avoid the "pay as you go" system like the plague. Were this System to prevail, how would \$71,000 hospital bills get paid? There would be no "business as usual."

How would endless cash be flying around the System. No government or private insurance companies would mean the multi-billion dollar gravy train would come to a grinding halt.

Cushy lifestyles and early vacations would evaporate.

THE IDEAL SCENE:

Given these considerations, the "ideal scene" for the American Health System could be postulated as a System of state-of-the-art, universal health care technologies and services that can be afforded by all individuals without insurance -- private or government.

Again, no one in the current Medical Terrorist Establishment wants to ratify THIS ideal scene.

The Medical Terrorist Establishment would implode if it the "pay as you go theory of health care" were to dominate because free market competition and innovation allowed it TO dominate.

WE THE SICK would become WE THE HEALTHY. The entire Medical Establishment would be forced to adopt a new Oath, perhaps "First do no harm, and then do a lot of good."

Even though this would be a revolution for WE THE PEOPLE, it would be a horrifying new reality for the mini gods that populate the Medical Terrorist Establishment and apologists of the status quo. But so what. They will adapt.

WE THE SICK could finally rejoice as we took control of the destiny of our health and lives. And as taxpayers and buyers of health care technology and services -- we can do this if we agree that most of the principles in this documentary, summarized below, make sense:

TITLE:

- 1) Realize the American Health System is a system of systems and any diagnosis and remedy must view it holistically.

- 2) The American Health System is comprised of food, pharmaceuticals, clinicians, hospitals, medical schools, media, private insurance and government.
- 3) All systems in the American Health System must be addressed and reformed simultaneously.
- 4) The quality and quantity of food WE THE SICK eat should be addressed and built into academia, from K through 12 to college and medical schools.
- 5) AI-driven Quantum Computers must be developed and brought on line as soon as possible to model proteins and viruses.
- 6) At least 10% of the welfare-warfare budgets should be allocated to health care research and technology.
- 7) Legislation that creates special privileges to inhibit competition or innovation should be rescinded and avoided.

NARRATOR

Reforming the American Health System is a non-partisan goal. The only thing that could possibly be partisan is how we do it.

Hopefully we have diagnosed the broad factors and provided a starting point for a constructive discussion.

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
